Sub: Issue/grant of "public performance" licences by Phonographic Performance Ltd

1. We have necessary copyright to many sound recordings / song videos both film and non-film genres, both new releases and catalogue, in several languages.
2. We are a long-standing member of "Phonographic Performance Ltd", having registered office at Crescent Towers, Off New Link Road, Andheri W, Mumbai ("PPL"), which is a company without share capital. As a member of PPL, vide a transfer agreement of even date, we have assigned exclusively to PPL the right in respect of "public performance". "Public performance" herein refers to playing of music in public places and/or by commercial establishments-- just to cite a few examples: hotel, lodge, restaurant, disco, pub, bowling alley, shop, store/shop, mall, spa, clinic/hospital, bank, office, business park, amusement park, aircraft, airport, bus, ship/boat, train/metro train, event, show/function, DJs, etc. etc. This includes playing of sound recordings through cassettes, CD, radio, television, cable, loud-speaker system, piped music, wi-fi, etc.
3. Accordingly, PPL is empowered and entitled to grant and issue, in its own name, letterhead, "public performance" licenses and invoices to establishments, organisations, premises, event organizers/managers, DJs etc for any such usage.
4. Further, PPL has been authorized the right to enforce the copyright for "public performance" against violations and infringements -including but not limited to by means of litigation (both civil and criminal) and police action, etc .
5. Failure to take appropriate public performance license from PPL in respect of sound recordings published by us, is a violation and infringement of our copyright.
